

# Facility Screening Questions

**Prior to entering the Entegris facility, please read and advise your Entegris screener if your answer to any of these questions is, “YES”:**

1. In the last 14 days have you traveled outside of your city, state, or province other than normal commuting distances?
2. To the best of your knowledge have you in the last 14 days:
  - a) been in close proximity with someone suspected or diagnosed with COVID-19,
  - b) shared a vehicle with someone suspected or diagnosed with COVID-19, or
  - c) been on a bus, plane, or ship in which someone was diagnosed with COVID-19?
3. Has anyone in your household been diagnosed with or suspected of having the COVID-19 virus in the last 14 days?
4. Are you experiencing any flu-like symptoms at this time (without medication)?

Fever >99.3F (37.4C)	Cough
Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing	Chills or repeated shaking with chills
Muscle pain	Headache
Sore throat	New loss of taste or smell

***A temperature above 99.3F (37.4C) does not mean you have COVID-19 or influenza***

## Additional Screening Information



- If the person has traveled internationally or visited a region listed as a High Risk, he/she must follow the Additional Precautionary Measures. Simply connecting through an airport or transiting through an area does not constitute a visit.
- If the person is healthy and thinks that they may have been in close proximity (i.e. within 2 meters, same room, same vehicle, same airplane, or cruise ship) with someone who has contracted or is suspected as having the virus, he/she must follow the Additional Precautionary Measures. This includes anyone suspected or diagnosed with COVID-19 in the household.
- If the person is feeling ill with flu like symptoms or has contracted or is suspected as having COVID-19, he/she is not allowed to enter the site and must be symptom free, without medication, for 72 hours before returning.
- Note that the site must comply with all local, state, province, and national authorities should there be a conflict with the above Entegris requirements

# Additional Precautionary Measures

*(must follow for 14 days since last day exposed)*

For personnel who have traveled internationally, visited a high risk region, or those who have been exposed to someone confirmed or suspect of COVID-19...

- Must wear a mask at all times while on site
- Practice strict social distancing of 2 meters
- Disinfect work area routinely
- Must self-monitor and if they develop flu-like symptoms, leave the site and advise their doctor immediately

- Ask your screener, supervisor, or EHS resource for a mask
- Supplies are limited so please use wisely

*The US CDC recommends that when out in public you should wear a cloth cover over your nose and mouth in place of a surgical mask to preserve the limited availability to those at higher risk such as health care providers*
